

Project Objectives and Description

The objectives of the Project are:

- to assist the Government to develop and implement outcomes-orientated monitoring and evaluation approaches in the health and education sectors;
- to improve the access of user groups to primary data, ensuring a sufficient dissemination of the results.

The Project consists of the following parts:

- Capacity Building in Designing and Implementing Survey Instruments for Assessing Outcomes in Health and Education:
 - provision of training workshops in results orientated monitoring and evaluation;
 - provision of technical assistance in questionnaire development and sampling design;
 - implementation of pilot surveys to test instruments developed and to provide data to feed the sectoral strategies and the Welfare Improvement Strategy.
- Strengthening Analytical Capacity and Links with Policy Making:
 - provision of training in data analyses;
 - provision of workshops for integration of results in sectoral strategies.
- Improve Access to Data and Dissemination of Results:
 - develop a website to enable users access to primary data;
 - provision of Workshops;
 - publication of results in the national language.
